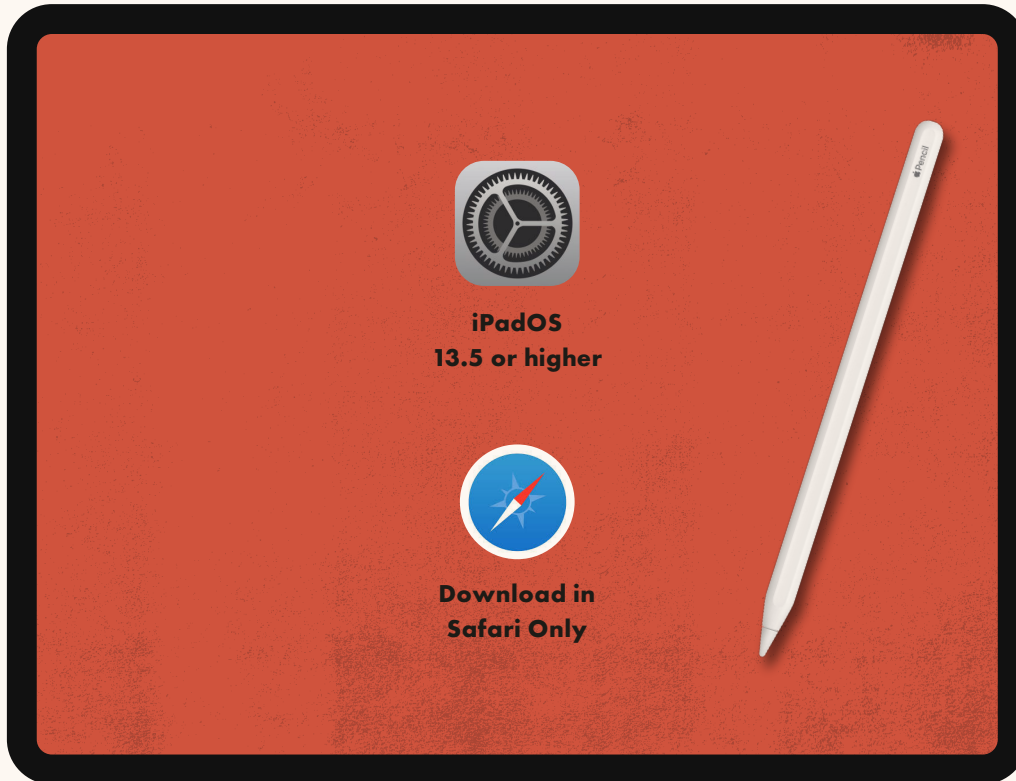

STEP 1

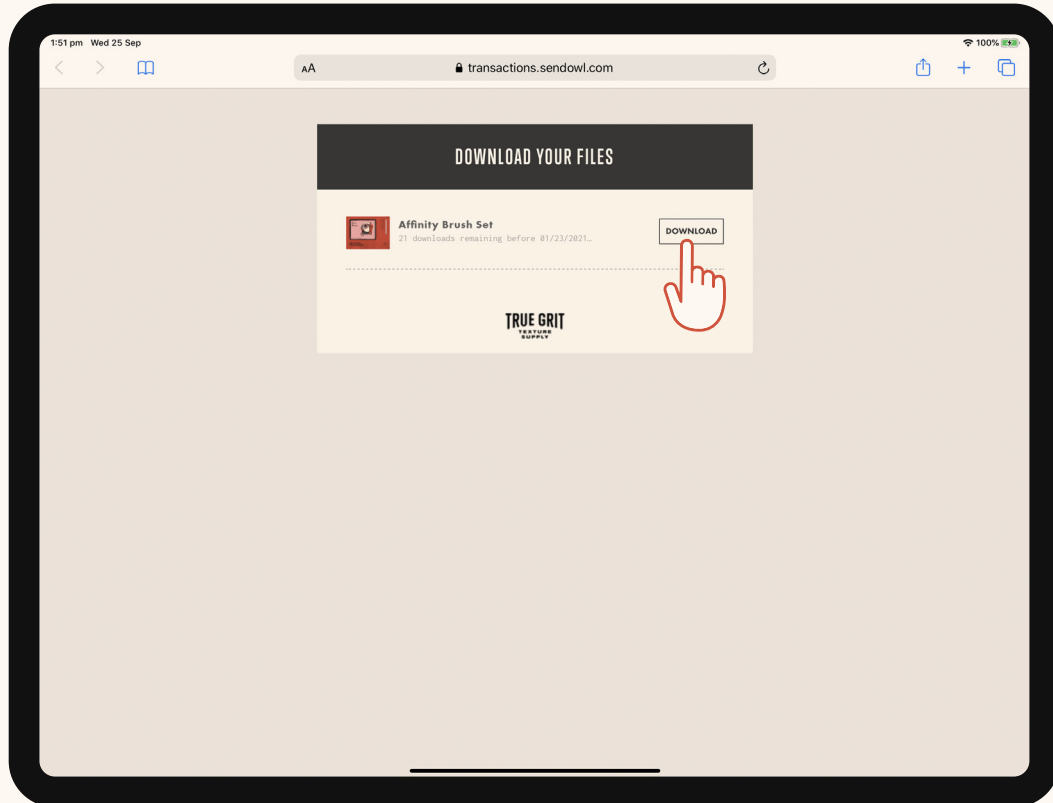
Ensure that iPadOS is up-to-date (13.5 or higher).

Instructions are for Safari only.



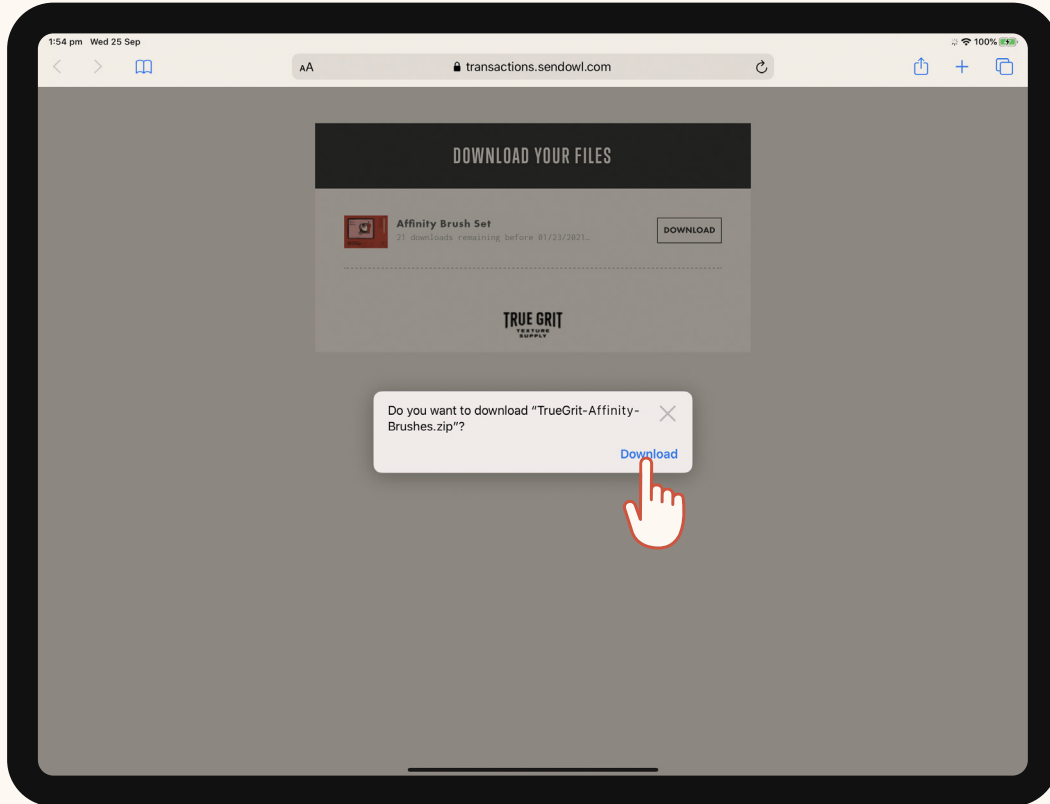
STEP 2

Open the Download Your Files page (you'll find a link in your order email) then tap the Download button to begin.



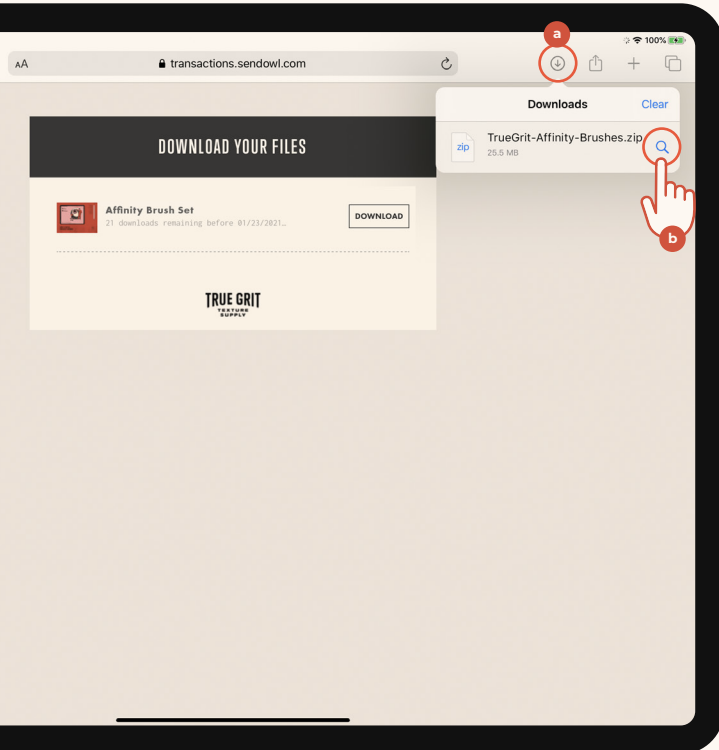
STEP 3

Tap Download when prompted.



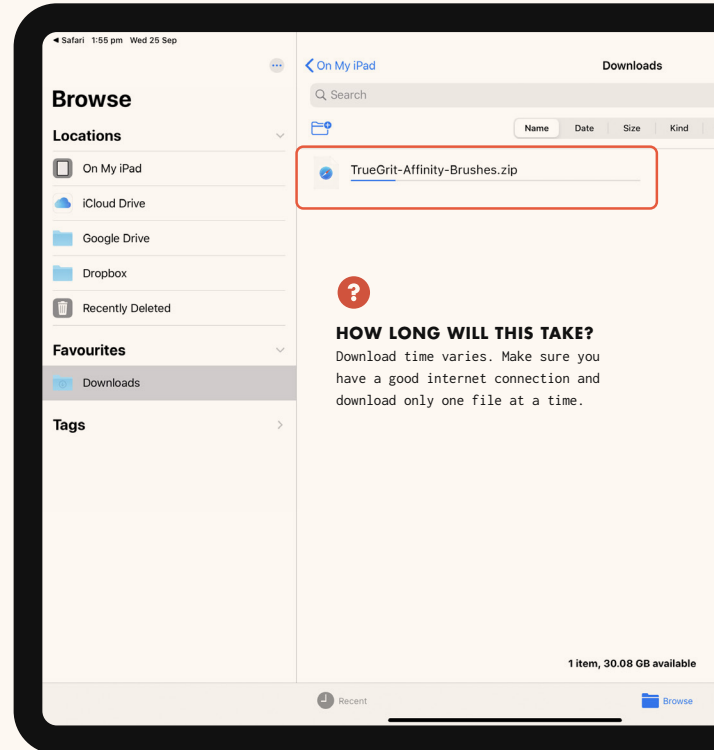
STEP 4

Tap the **Downloads Button** (a) then tap the **Magnify/Search Icon** (b).



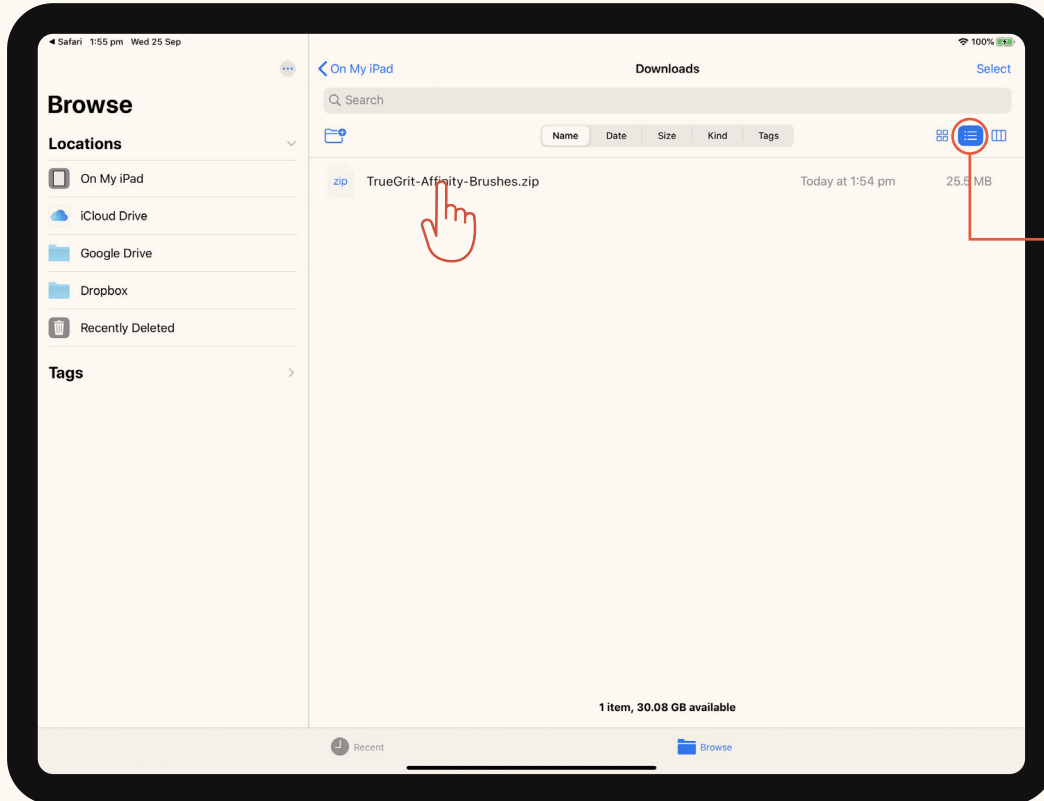
STEP 5

This opens the Downloads folder.
Wait for the zip file to download!



STEP 6

Tap the .zip file to extract the folder and its contents.

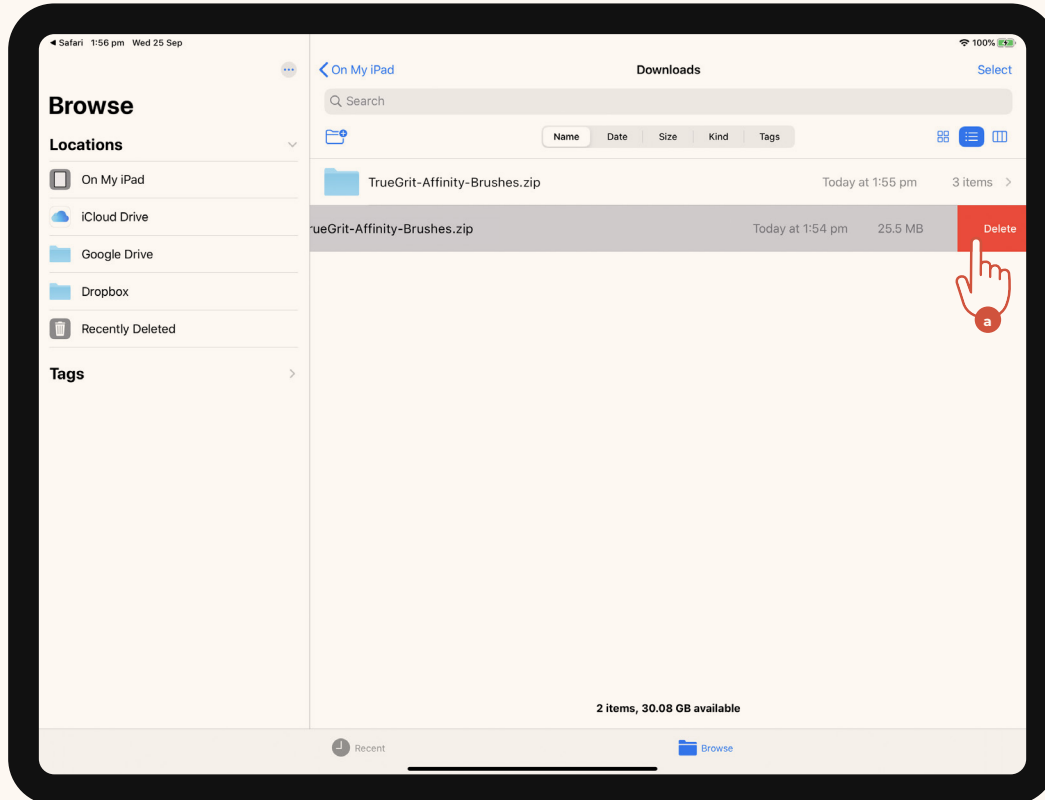


HANDY TIP

We're viewing our files in List View. Drag down to reveal the file viewing options bar.

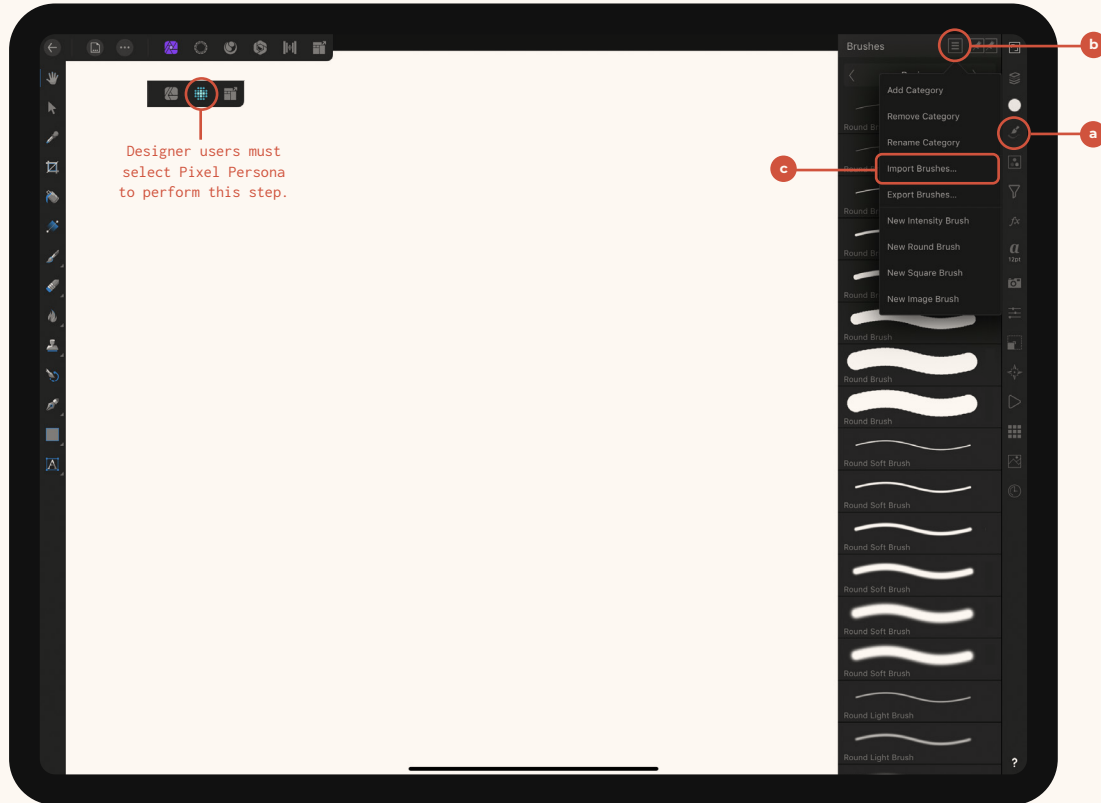
STEP 7

To save storage space, swipe left to delete the zip file.



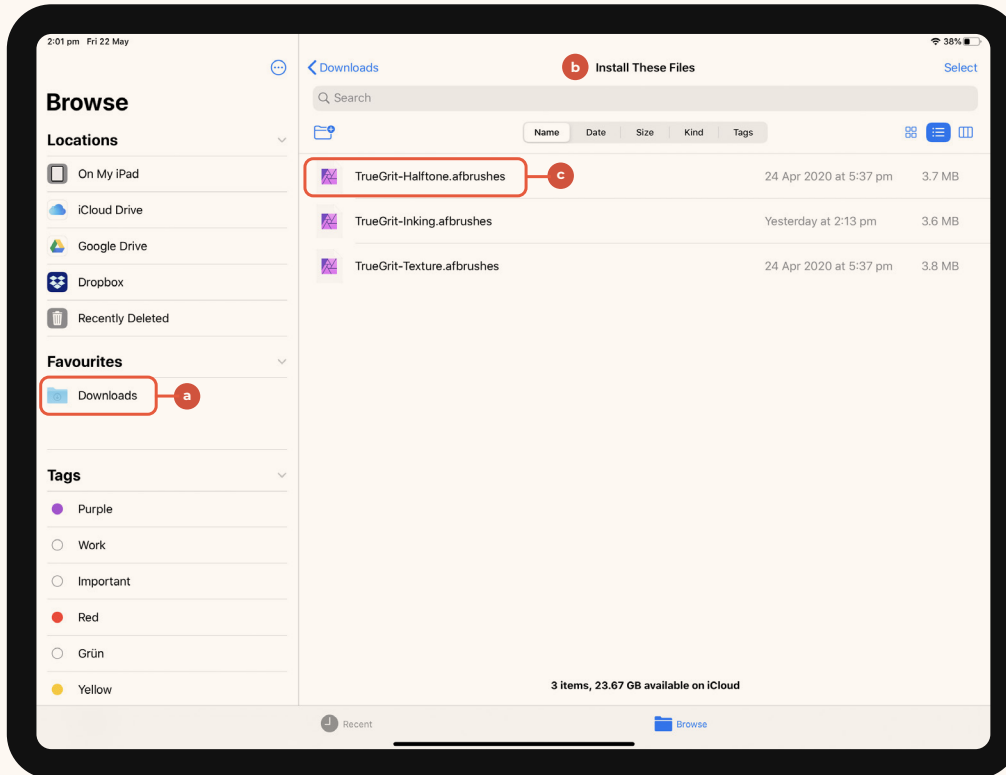
STEP 8

Open Photo or Designer then select the Paint Brush panel (a),
tap the Options menu (b) then tap Import Brushes (c)



STEP 9

The file browser will open. Go to Downloads (a) then open the downloaded product file followed by the Install These Files folder (b). Tap the first brush set to install it (c). You can only install 1 brush set at a time.

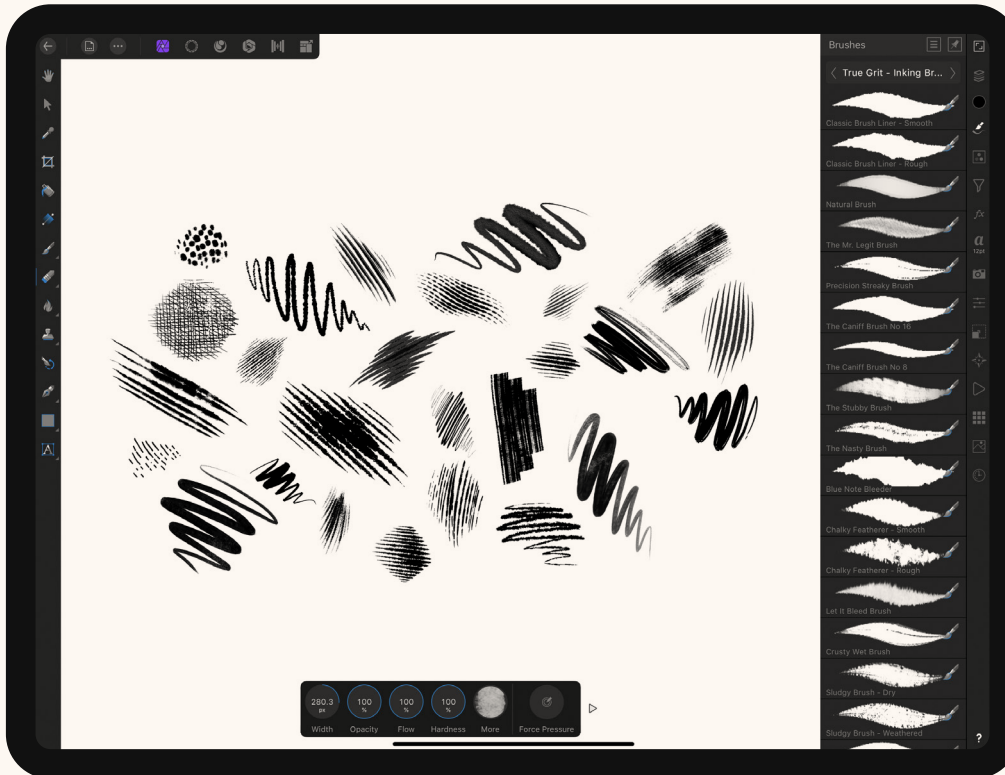


STEP 10

Repeat steps 8 and 9 for all remaining brush sets.

ALMOST THERE

Your brushes are installed and are almost ready to use. But first, we need to edit the pencil pressure curve so your brushes behave as intended.



ABOUT iPad PRESSURE CURVE SETTINGS

Affinity's brush engine behaves a little differently on the iPad causing some brushes to lose their nuance and sensitivity. This is especially problematic when using inking or shading brushes.

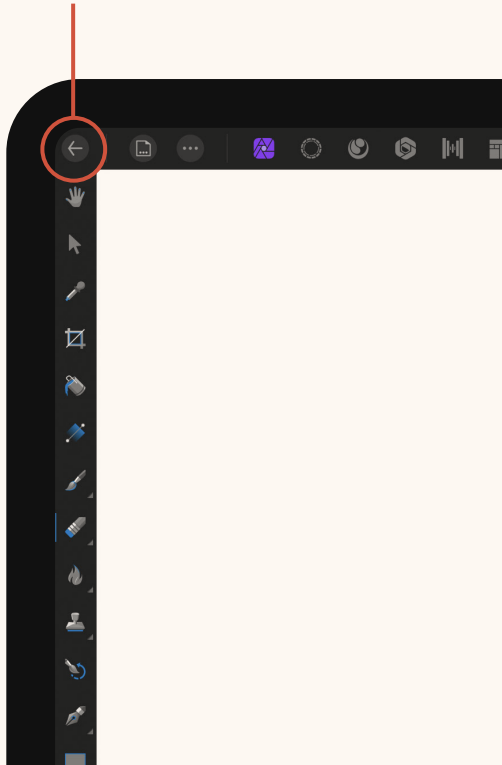

HOW TO CUSTOMIZE YOUR PENCIL PRESSURE CURVE SETTINGS

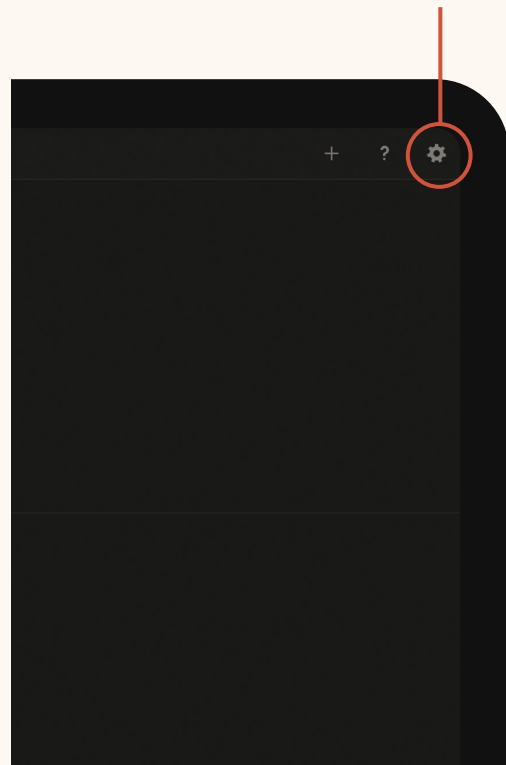
STEP 1

Tap the back/arrow button to go to the welcome screen.



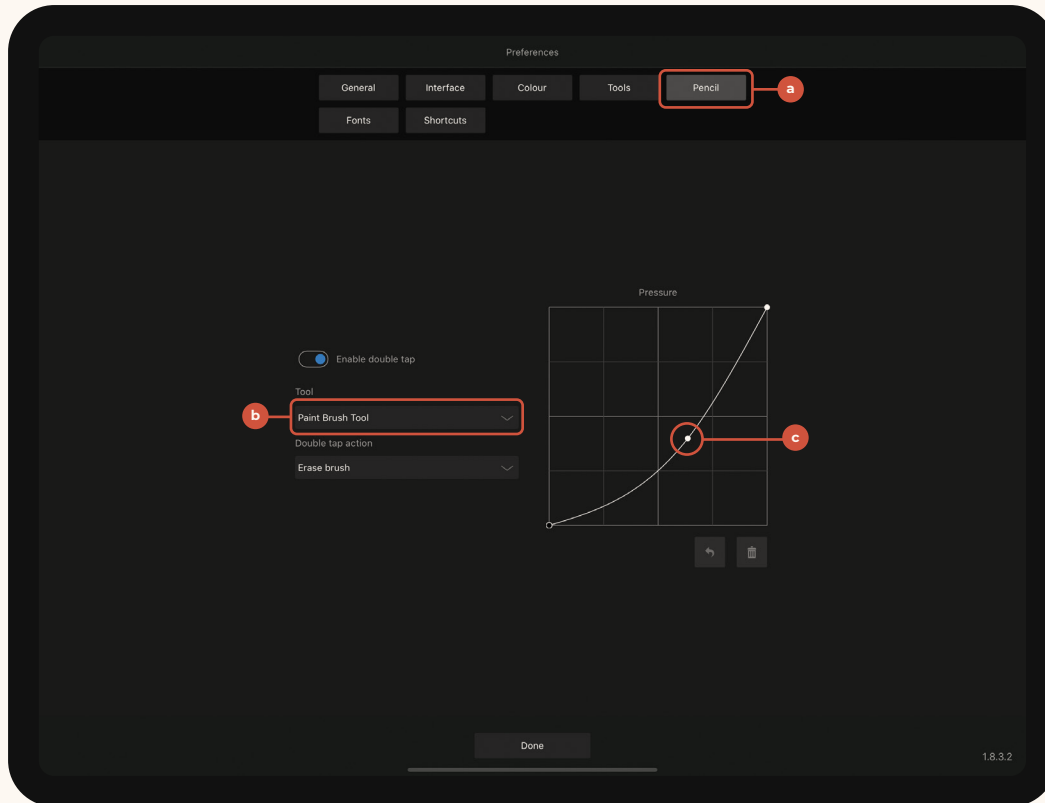
STEP 2

Tap the cog icon to go to the settings screen.



STEP 3

Tap the Pencil tab (a), choose Paint Brush Tool from the Tool menu (b) then adjust the pressure curve as shown (c). Tap Done to save the new settings.
