



HOW TO INSTALL PROCREATE BRUSHES FROM YOUR DESKTOP

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

HARDWARE:

Apple Desktop or Macbook,
Apple iPad Pro
Apple Pencil or iPad
compatible stylus

SOFTWARE:

Apple iOS 12 or higher +
Procreate 4 or higher

iPad STORAGE:

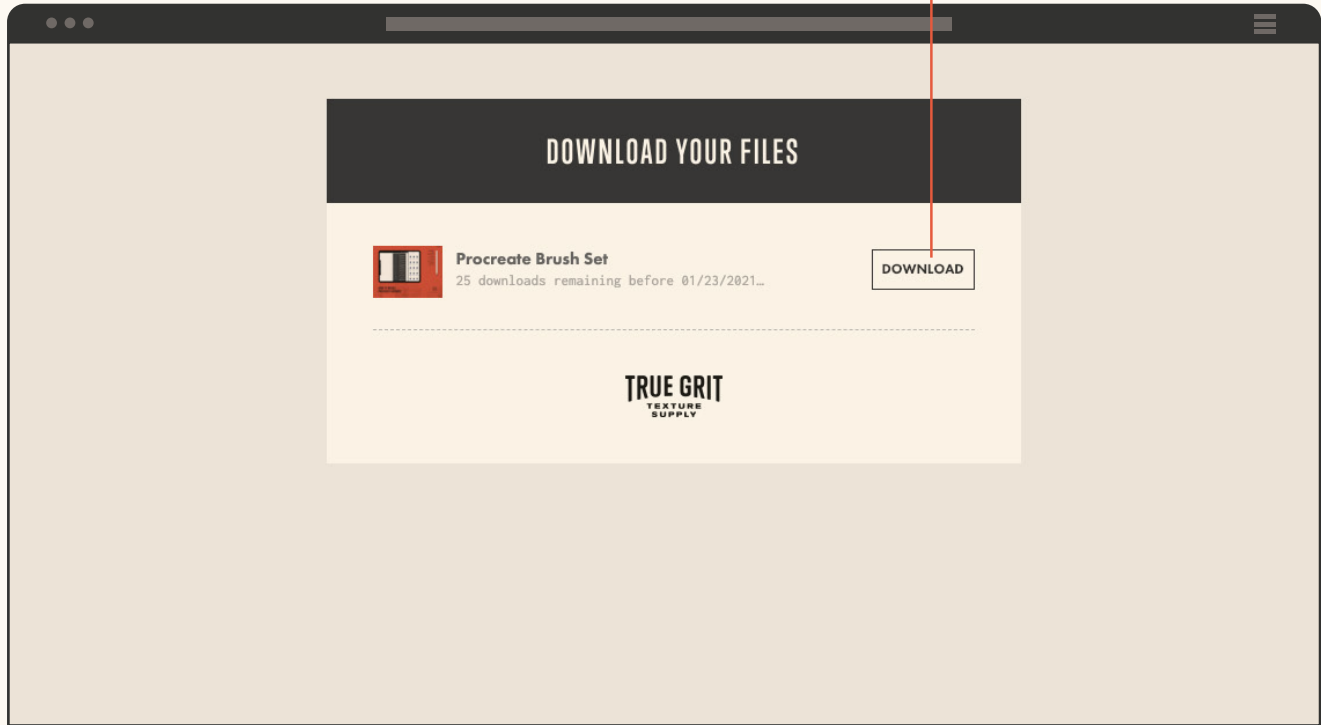
Up to 100MB of

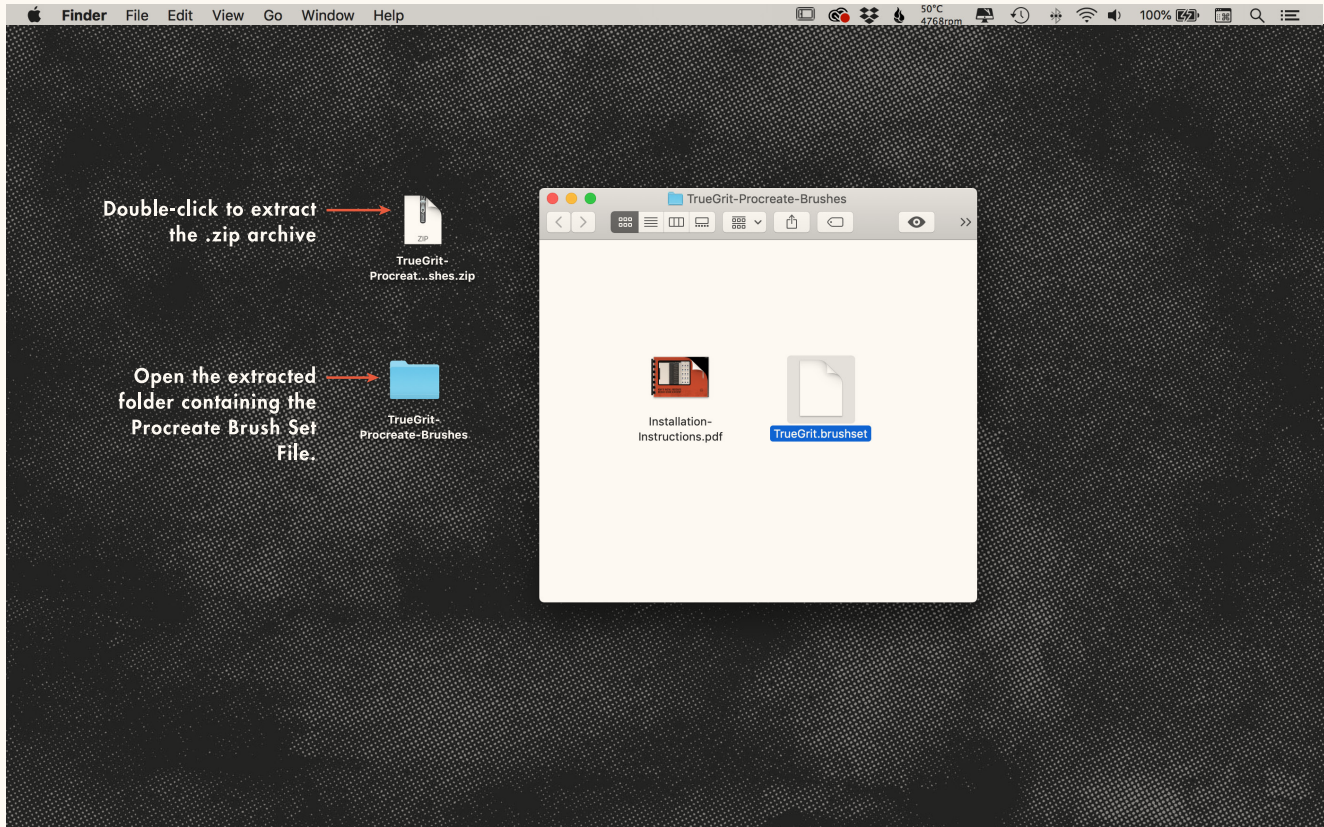
STEP 1

Download the .zip file to your desktop from the order download page.



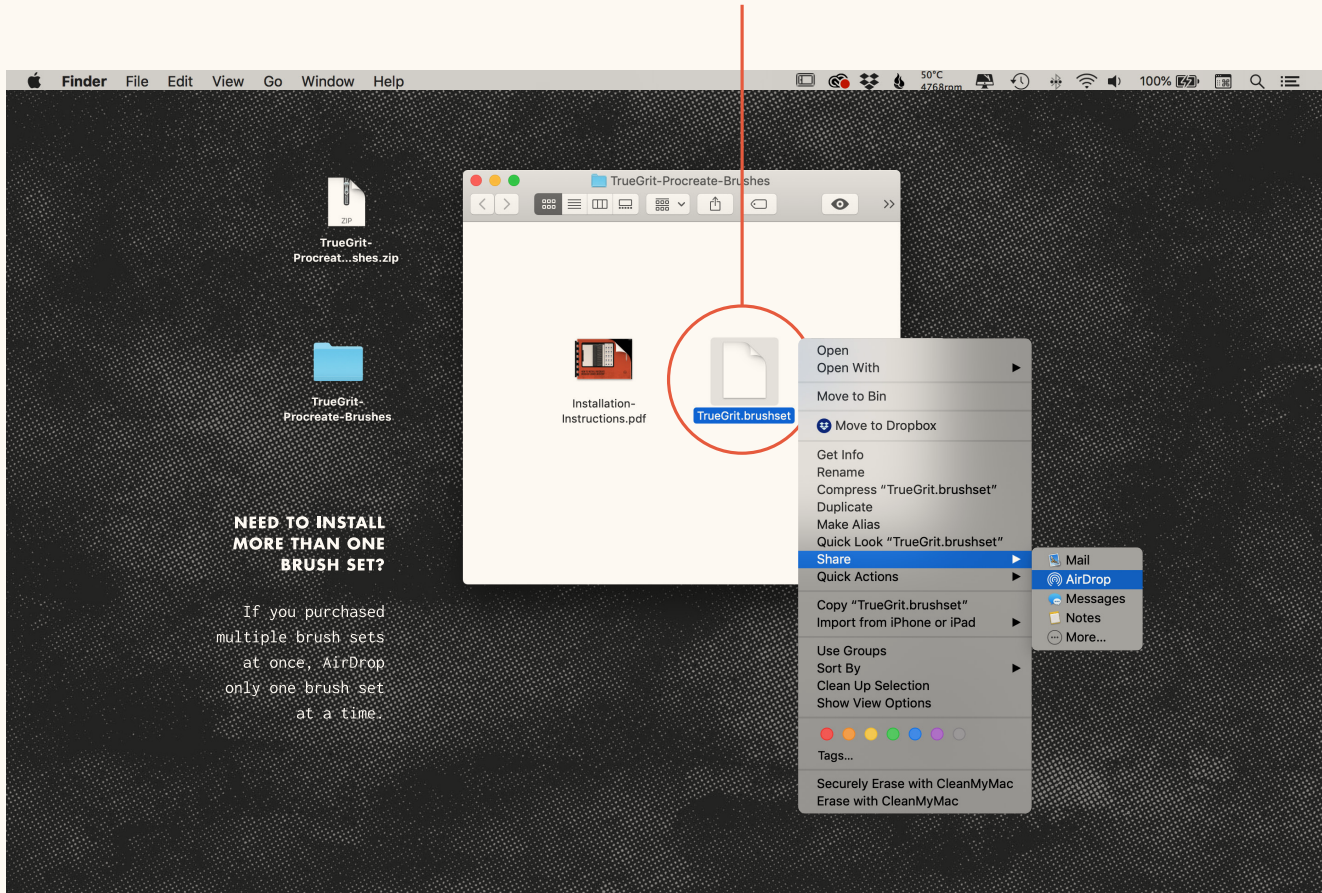
STEP 2

Double-click to extract the .zip archive then open the extracted folder containing your brushset file.



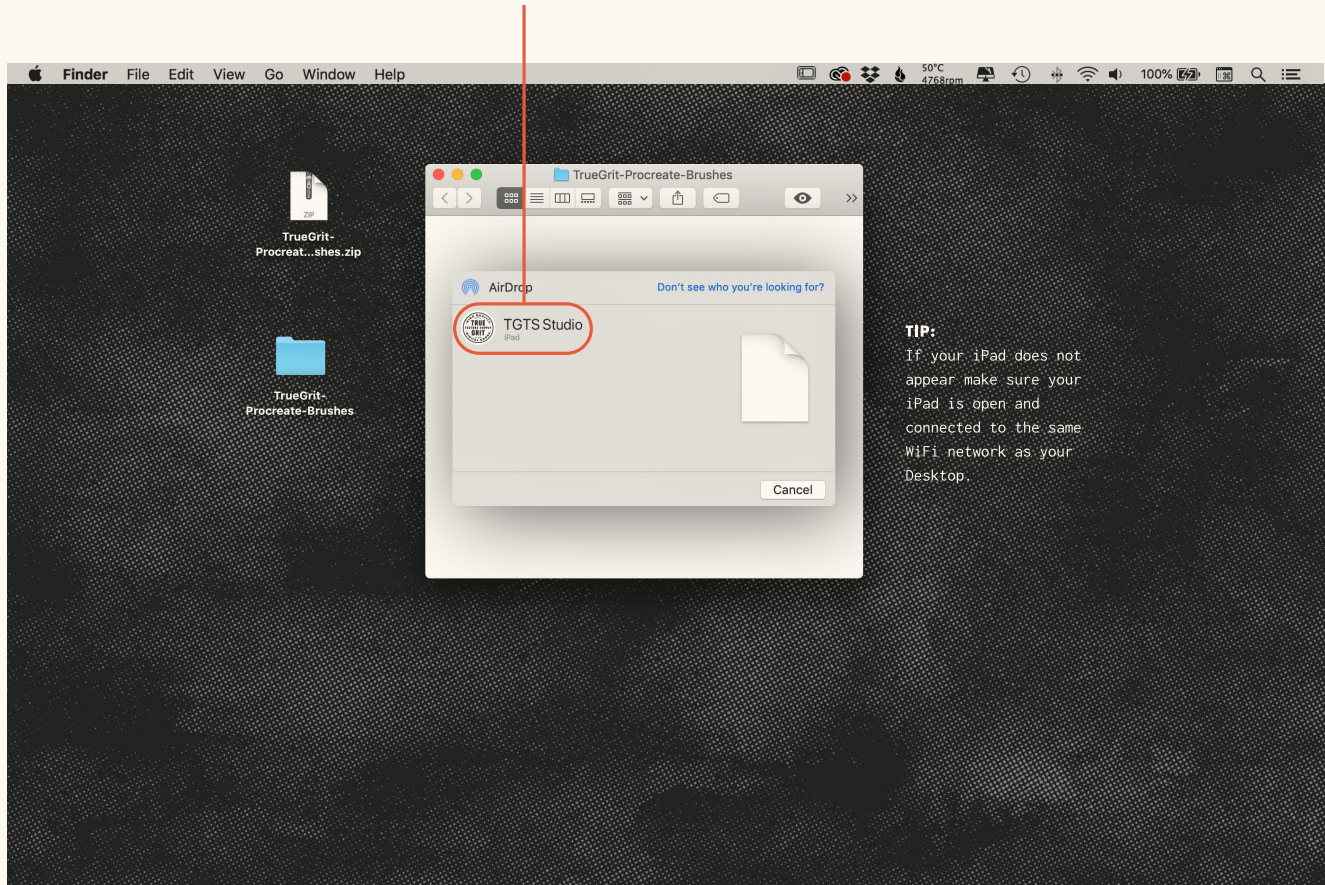
STEP 3

Right-click the Procreate Brush Set file (file extension .brushset) and go to **Share > AirDrop**.



STEP 4

Choose your iPad as the AirDrop destination

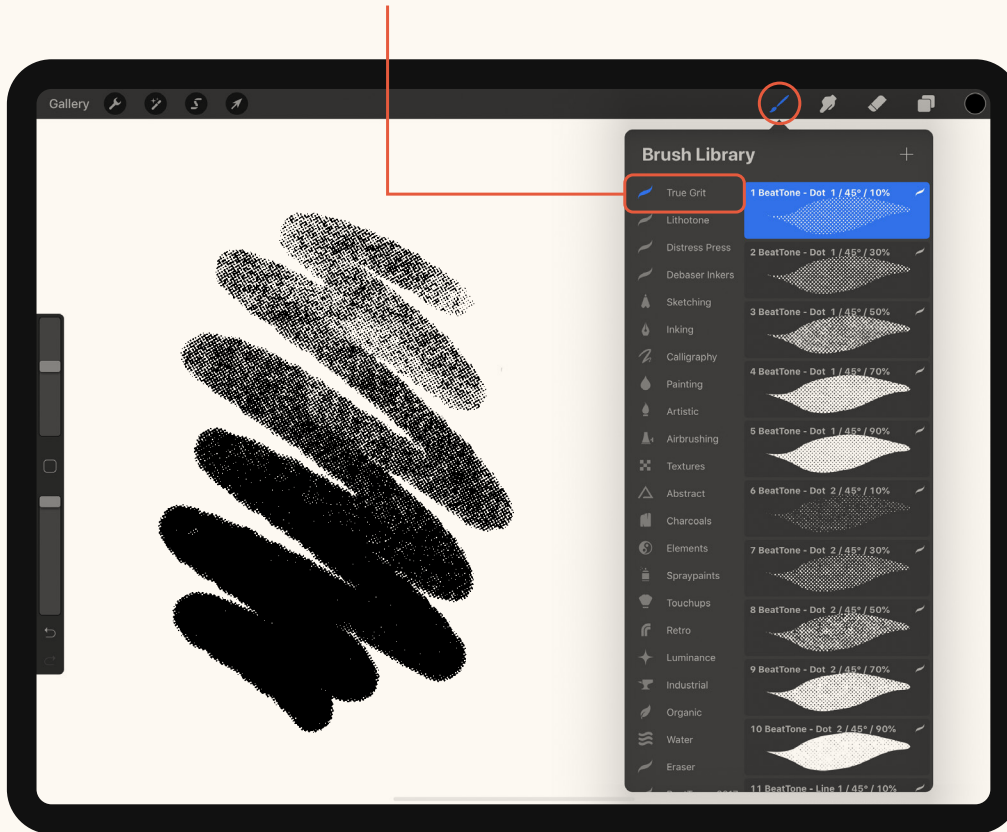


TIP:

If your iPad does not appear make sure your iPad is open and connected to the same WiFi network as your Desktop.

SUCCESS!

Fire up Procreate and you'll find your brushes ready and waiting in a new brush set at the top of the Brush Library.
